SSNS Regional Golf Tournament Monday Sept 26th, 2022 Info and Supplemental Local Rules

Classification

Open Boys, Open Girls

Regional Representation

Top four teams/Region and any of the top five finishers at the Regional Tournament who are not on a school team advancing. In Regional competition for boys, up to four participants may compete on a team. The top three scores will count and all team members will advance. In Regional Competition for girls, up to four participants may compete. The top two scores will count and all team members will advance.

Team Composition

A maximum of four girls, and four boys may be registered from each school.

Boys: Three or four players – top three scores to count.

Girls: Two, three or four players – top two scores to count.

Individuals are permitted to compete in District, Regional and Provincial competition, should a school not have enough to enter a team.

Arrival and Departure time:

Players should arrive at the course to allow for an adequate warm up before their Tee Time. Players are welcome to remain at the course after their round to purchase food, or, watch their peers on the finishing hole.

Rules of Play

- 1. RCGA rules govern play. NSGA Standard Local Rules, and these Supplementary Rules will govern play can be found at: https://sites.google.com/gnspes.ca/nssaf/sports/golf
- 2. Conduct determined to be detrimental to the best interest of the games, both on and off the course will result in disqualification.
- 3. Dress shorts or golf slacks or skirt and a golf shirt with a collar. Hat, if worn, is to be turned around properly. NO JEANS.
- 4. Players should have a personal identification mark on their ball.
- 5. Competitors may not receive advice during play. The penalty is disqualification. Team coaches are expected to maintain a reasonable distance from the golfers.
 - 6. In Regional and Provincial Tournaments, a player may take a **maximum of ten (10)** strokes per hole
 - 7. **Competitive Rules of Golf Apply** you must hit a provisional golf ball for all potential lost balls.
 - 8. Golfers in the **Boys division** will play from the **White Tees.** Golfers in the **Girls division** will play from the **Red Tees**.
 - 9. Please turn scorecards in for marking in the scoring area by the restaurant.
 - 10. NO CELL PHONE POLICY IS IN EFFECT. NO USE OF CELL PHONES AT ANY TIME.
 - 11. PLEASE KEEP UP TO THE GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU. PACE OF PLAY WILL BE STRICTLY MONITORED.

Local Rules:

- 12. The following is considered **ground under repair** and relief is provided under rule 25-1 (you may lift the ball and drop it within one club-length to the nearest point of relief).
 - A ball that comes to rest on exposed rock within the fairway or rough only;
 - A ball that comes to rest in the rock garden on the right of hole 11
- 13. Large Boulders (Example hole 10, 14, 18) are a part of the golf course and **no relief** is provided
- 14. The ditch along the left side of **hole15** is not a French Drain, and the ball must be played as it lies.

15. **Hole 16**

- All Golfers must play a second ball, if their 1st ball fails to cross the water hazard, if their 2nd ball fails to cross the water hazard they must play a third ball. After their 3rd ball goes into the hazard they should mark a 9 on their scorecard and proceed to the next hole.

PLAYOFFS / Tie Breaking procedure: All ties will be decided by retrogression:

Individual competition:

1st. tie breaker – Best total score on the last 9 holes

2nd tie breaker – Best total score on the last 6 holes

3rd tie breaker - Best total score on the last 3 holes

4th tie breaker - Best score on the 18th hole.

Team Event:

1st. tie breaker – Combination of top three team members last 9 holes

2nd tie breaker – Combination of top three team members last 6 holes

3rd tie breaker - Combination of top three team members last 3 holes

4th tie breaker - Combination of top three team members 18th hole score
