Competition

Preliminary Rounds: Round Robin

- One game consists of 21 points in all age/gender classes in the round robin.
- At 20 all, the side which gains a 2 point lead first, wins that game.
- At 29 all, the side scoring the 30th point, wins that game.
- Switch sides when the lead score is 11 points.

Cross Over Rounds

- Best of 3 Games to 21 points.
- At 20 all, the side which gains a 2 point lead first, wins that game.
- At 29 all, the side scoring the 30th point, wins that game.
- The side winning a game serves first in the next game.
- Switch sides after each game and for the third game when the lead score reaches 11 points.
- Coaches may meet with their players for 2 minutes in between games. On the court!
- → There is a maximum of 8 students permitted to compete at each level. (Girls Singles, Boys Singles, Girls Doubles, Boys Doubles, Mixed Doubles)
- → You can only compete in one event.
- → Top 2 individual finishers advance to Regionals on Wednesday, April 10th.
- → Top 2 teams will advance to the Regional Tournament (Please see below for how team points are calculated at the Metro Tournament).

The Regional Tournament for all classifications (Junior, Intermediate & Senior) will be held at Citadel High School - Wed. April 12th.

Team Points

Individuals will score team points for their school if they have at least 4 out of 5 sections entered. Points will be awarded as follows:

5 Points for 1st place

4 Points for 2nd place

3 Points for 3rd place

2 Points for 4th place

1 Point for 5th place
