When I get all of that information I will send out an invoice to each team. Please make sure to send your cheque to Bay View the week you get it so funds will not have to be tracked down.

There seems to still be some coaches/teams complaining about the length of the girls' games. All coaches and teams were informed every year that the game length can increase, if they have ice to support that. The ice time will not be able to start before 4 pm. We tried to get teams to increase ice times about five years ago and only one team was able to secure a game slot for 1.5 hours. Please let your coaches know that if this is something they want for their team, they will need to have ice time after 4pm for at least 1.5 hours to increase the game times. They will need to have that secured this

spring when arenas do their bookings for next season. Angela Dale mentioned that at Millwood they may be taking some ice from the boy's team to make it even for both. If that is the case at your schools we will need to know ahead of the season so games can be scheduled accordingly.
