Spectators or parents are allowed, but cannot enter the school before 4pm. Competitors are not allowed in any areas other than the gym and the main hall. Only the players, coaches, and school reps will be allowed before 4pm. Parking may be limited at 4pm but will clear quickly.

4:15pm Opening announcements and matches to immediately follow.

Schedules for athletes' times will be shared once all competitor information is collected.

Competition

Preliminary Rounds: Round Robin

- One game consists of 15 points in all age/gender classes in the round robin. Win by 2-points.
- At 15 all, the side which gains a 2-point lead first, wins that game. If a two-point advantage
 can't be achieved the player/team that reaches 21 points first wins
- Switch sides when the lead score is 8 points.

Cross Over Rounds

- 1 Game to 21 points. Win by 2
- Players switch sides at 11 points
- At 21 all, the side which gains a 2-point lead first, wins that game.
- If a 2-point lead cannot be achieved, the player/team that reaches 30 first wins
- There is a maximum of 8 students permitted to compete at each level. (Girls Singles, Boys Singles, Girls Doubles, Boys Doubles, Mixed Doubles)
- You can only compete in one event.
- The top 2 individual finishers advance to Regionals on Wednesday, April 10th.
- The top 2 teams will advance to the Regional Tournament (Please see below for how team points are calculated at the Metro Tournament).

Team Points

Individuals will score team points for their school if they have at least 4 out of 5 sections entered.

Points will be awarded as follows:

5 Points for 1 place

4 Points for 2 place

3 Points for 3 place

2 Points for 4 place

1 Point for 5 place

If you do not rank your athletes or send a team list, your players will be randomly placed in pools. The ranking should allow for an even and fair playing field.

When we receive all entries, we will send out times for all competitor divisions boys singles, boys doubles, girls singles, girls doubles, and mixed doubles.

Athletes can only play in one event and age class. Schools can only enter one student in each event.

There will be awards to the top three individuals in every class.

- 7. The Mavis 300 is the tournament shuttle (Yellow).
- 8. Top **two** finishers (Individual) in each classification will advance to Regionals.

- 9. <u>REGIONALS</u> will be held at <u>Citadel High School</u> on Wednesday, April 10th for all divisions. The Individual Competition will start at 9:00am with the Team Competition following the completion of the individual competition.
- 10. The team winners will be compiled from the placing of the individual events in the districts. Top 2 Teams will advance.
