

Metro High School Soccer League 2024 Girls B Information

League Format:

Format is a 7-team league playing one division round robin schedule for the B league. Teams - Sacred Heart, Eastern Shore, Island View, Cole Harbour, West Bedford, Halifax Grammar, Sommet

JV will play a double round robin. Teams - JL, Lockview, Citadel

3 points for a win and 1 point for a tie. At the end of round robin the top team is the league winner.

In case of a tie after Round robin:

1. Head to Head (games between tied teams)
2. Goal differential
(During round robin play – only a max. of 5 goals for will be recorded)
3. Goals against
4. Goals for
5. Cards (teams with the least amount of cards moves on)
6. Top team in each Division play off for Champion

The cost of officials for all games will be split, so each team will be billed for division and also field cost at the end of the season. Cheques made out to Island View High School.

Home team brings a game sheet and game balls.

Game times are either 4:00, 4:15 or 5:15.

Responsibilities of home team:

1. Provide the game sheet
2. Provide two quality game balls

Responsibilities of winning team:

- In case of a tie the home team takes on this responsibility.

Make sure you include the goalie shutouts and who scored for both teams. Also include any cards indicated on the game sheet. Please send a full game sheet.

Responsibilities of the Away Team:

- In case of conflicting shirt colors; the away team will change or wear pinnies. Make sure you have a set of 11 of the same color.

Rescheduling games:

- If it is absolutely necessary for a game to be rescheduled the team canceling the game must get the approval of the opponent coach, and establish an agreeable time to play the game.

- The **team canceling** the game **is responsible for:** immediately contacting the coordinator about the schedule change, and rescheduling the new booking, canceling the referees and rescheduling referees for the new game. If a game is not completed the team that initiated the cancellation shall forfeit the game, the game will be recorded as a 3 – 0 win for the opponent. In the event a team does not show up to a game the same will take place. If a game is canceled the day of then the referee's must be paid.
