1. Top four teams per region and any of the top five finishers at the Regional Tournament who are not on a school team advance onto Provincial championships. Please confirm that your students will compete at provincials ASAP. Notify Justine Colley-Leger (<a href="mailto:jcolley-leger@halifaxgrammar.ca">jcolley-leger@halifaxgrammar.ca</a>). right away if they cannot attend.

## 2. Participants

- a. Each school may register a maximum of four girls, and four boys.
- b. In Regional Competition
  - i. Boys: Four players top three scores to count.
  - ii. Girls: Two, three or four players top two scores to count.
  - iii. Individuals are permitted to compete in Regional and Provincial competition, should a school not have enough to enter a team.
- 3. Please register your team by sending the attached "Golf Regionals Team Entry 2024" to Justine Colley-Leger at: <a href="mailto:icolley-leger@halifaxgrammar.ca">icolley-leger@halifaxgrammar.ca</a>
  - a. The deadline to register is September 19th at 6:00pm.
  - b. The sooner the better for Grandview Golf Course.
- 4. Please make sure that only Coaches make Green Fee payments at the Pro Shop. \$50.00/player.
- 5. There will be a 10-stroke maximum for girls and boys on each hole.
- 6. Players must keep the score of another student in their group. At the end of the round they must sign and hand that scorecard back to the owner of the card. Students need to submit their card to their coach and then coaches will confirm the scores with their players and then finally turn all of their players cards into Darrell MacInnis or Justine Coley-Leger at the end of the round.
- 7. Results will be shared with the SSNS and Metro ADs the following day.

- 8. SSNS Provincial Championship will be held in the Northumberland Region-Truro on October 1st. The course still to be confirmed.
- 9. Tee off assignments will be sent out prior to the competition. It is a 7:30am start.
- 10. Boys play from the white tees, girls from the forward tees.
- 11. Cell phones are not permitted on the course, but handheld GPS devices are allowed.
- 12. Coaches and parents are not allowed to give advice; they are permitted to follow at a respectful distance.
- 13. PLAYOFFS / Tie Breaking procedure: All ties will be decided by retrogression
  - a. Individual competition:
    - i. 1st tie breaker Best total score on the last 9 holes
    - ii. 2nd tie breaker Best total score on the last 6 holes
    - iii. 3rd tie breaker Best total score on the last 3 holes
    - iv. 4th tie breaker Best score on the 18th hole
  - b. Team Event:
    - i. 1st. tie breaker Combination of top three team members last 9 holes
    - ii. 2nd tie breaker Combination of top three team members last 6 holes
    - iii. 3rd tie breaker Combination of top three team members last 3 holes
    - iv. 4th tie breaker Combination of top three team members 18th hole score
