Badminton Tournament Rules

- A maximum of **8 players** are permitted to compete at each level.
- Players may only compete in **one event**. (BS, GS, BD, GD, MD)
 - o BS Boys Singles
 - o **GS** Girls Singles
 - o BD Boys Doubles
 - o **GD** Girls Doubles
 - o MD Mixed Doubles
- The top 2 finishers in each event advance to Regionals (Wed., Apr. 9th @ Citadel).
- The **top 2 teams** in each classification will advance to **Regionals** (Wed., Apr. 9th @ Citadel).
 - The **top 2 teams** will be determined using the following **point system**:
 - 1st place = 4 points
 - 2nd place = 3 points
 - 3rd place = 2 points
 - 4th place = 1 points

Tiebreaker Rule

• In the event of a tie in team standings, the **team with the highest individual or** pair placement will break the tie.

Competition

Preliminary Rounds: Round Robin

- One game to 21 points.
- At 20 all, the side which gains a 2 point lead first, wins that game.
- At 29 all, the side scoring the 30th point wins that game.
- Switch sides when the lead score is 11 points

Cross Over rounds: Top 2 teams from round robin advance

- Best of 3 games to 21 points.
- At 20 all, the side which gains a 2 point lead first, wins that game.
- At 29 all, the side scoring the 30th point wins that game.
- The side winning a game serves first the next game.
- Switch sides after each game and for the 3rd game when the lead score reaches 11.
- Coaches may meet with their players for 2 minutes in between games on the court.

A: High Skill

B: Average skill

C: weak skill
