# Competition

#### Preliminary Rounds : Round Robin

- One game consists of 15 points. Win by 2-points.
- If a two-point advantage can't be achieved the player/team that reaches 21 points first wins
- Switch sides when the lead score is 8 points.

#### **Cross Over Rounds**

- 1 Game to 21 points. Win by 2
- Players switch sides at 11 points
- At 21 all, the side which gains a 2-point lead first, wins that game.
- If a 2-point lead cannot be achieved, the player/team that reaches 30 first wins
- The top 2 individual finishers advance to Regionals on Wednesday, April 10th.
- The top 2 teams will advance to the Regional Tournament (Please see below for how team points are calculated at the Metro Tournament).

### **Team Points**

Individuals will score team points for their school if they have at least 4 out of 5 sections entered. The top 2 teams will be determined using the following point system:

- 1st place = 4 points
- 2nd place = 3 points
- 3rd place = 2 points
- 4th place = 1 points

\*\*Please note that there is no more point allocation for fifth place. We will complete a fifth place match if time permits if both teams/players want to stay, but no points will be allocated.

#### GOGGLES ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL PLAY AND WARM-UP!

EACH SCHOOL MUST SEND A TEACHER/COACH TO BE WITH THEIR TEAM AT ALL TIMES.

Registration fee is \$10.00 per athlete. Top **two** finishers (Individual) in each classification will advance to Regionals.

The team winners will be compiled from the placing of the individual events in the districts. Top 2 Teams will advance.
