League Format:

Format is a 8-team league playing one division round robin schedule for the B league.

1. Armbrae Academy
2. Citadel
3. Cole Harbour
4. Eastern Shore
5. Islandview
6. Lockview
7. Sacred Heart School
8. Sommet

Provincial Dates:

Division 2 Girls - November 6/7, 2026 (Highland Region)

Division 3 Girls - November 6/7, 2026 (Capital Region)

3 points for a win and **1 point** for a tie. At the end of round robin the top team is the league winner.

In case of a tie after Round robin:

1. **Points in head-to-head matches:** Results and points earned only in games between the specific tied teams.
2. **Goal difference in head-to-head:** Superior goal difference from matches played among the tied teams.
3. **Overall goal difference:** Total goals scored minus total goals conceded across all group games
4. **Goals scored:** Greatest number of total goals scored in all group matches.
5. **Fair play points:** Team conduct based on yellow and red cards accumulated (-1 for yellow, -3 for second yellow/red, -4 for straight red).

The cost of officials for all games will be split, so each team will be billed for

division and also field cost at the end of the season. Teams will be invoiced by the end of September for league fees.

Responsibilities of home team:

1. Provide the game sheet
2. Provide two quality game balls

Responsibilities of winning team:

In case of a tie the home team takes on this responsibility.

Responsibilities of the Away Team:

In case of conflicting shirt colors; the away team will change or wear pinnies. Make sure you have a set of 11 of the same color.

Rescheduling games:

If it is absolutely necessary for a game to be rescheduled the team canceling the game must get the approval of the opponent coach, and establish an agreeable time to play the game. There are make-up dates in the schedule.

The **team canceling** the game **is responsible for:** immediately contacting the coordinator about the schedule change, and rescheduling the new booking, canceling the referees and rescheduling referees for the new game. If a game is not completed the team that initiated the cancellation shall forfeit the game, the game will be recorded as a 3 – 0 win for the opponent. In the event a team does not show up to a game the same will take place. If a game is canceled the day of then the referee's must be paid.
